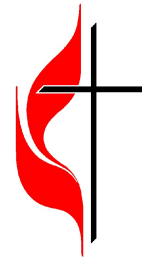
CARPET SHAMPOOING is scheduled for this week. Please check with the custodian or church office about access to carpeted areas and respective working/drying times. Thanks!
